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## He KUPU NŌ TE TUMUAKI

Tēnā tātou e te whānau.

“Māku anō tōku whare e hanga. Ko ngā pou  
o roto he mahoe, he patete, ko te tāhūhū he  
hīnau” – Kīngi Tāwhiao

Ko te ngākau hihiko nei e whakaputa ana i tēnei karere ki a koutou. Hei te mutunga o te wiki tuarua, ka rewa tō tātou paepūrongo hou, a Te Kete Whakairo. He pae matihiko tēnei mō ngā ākonga, ngā mātua me ngā kaiako, e māmā ai te toro atu ki ngā taipito kōrero ā kura.

E rua ōna pae. Tuatahi ake, he pae mā ngā ākonga me ngā kaiako ki te tuku, ki te wānanga, ki te mahi me te aromatawai i ngā tūmahi. Ki konei rewa ai ko ngā kaupapa hei mahi mā ngā ākonga ahakoa ki hea, ahakoa te wā. Ka aromatawaihia ngā tūmahi a ngā tamariki, ka utaina te taumata, ka taunakihia e te kaiako. Ka mutu, ka tuku tēnei taunakitanga ki te pae mātua. Koia nei te pae tuarua. He pae kua waihangatia mā ngā mātua. Ka rewa i konei ngā taunakitanga hei pūrongo. Ka rīpoatahia ngā wahanga e toru o tō tamaiti, o ōu nā tamariki.

1. Te taenga mai o tō tamaiti ki te kura.
2. Ko te wahanga ki ngā whanonga
  - a. Ngā whanonga pai
  - b. Ngā whanonga me whakapakari ake
3. Ko te wahanga ako

Kia kite ai tātou, he pēhea te ahunga o tō tamaiti.

Nā Te Wharekura o Kirikiriroa tēnei i hanga. He tuatahitanga hoki tēnei i ngā kura puta noa i a Aotearoa. Nō reira, he mea hou tēnei. Kāore anō ōna tukanga, ōna kōkiritanga kua whakamātau mā te tuku ki tētahi whakaminenga rahi.

Ngā kokenga whakamua:

1. Ka whakapātia koutou e te kaiako. He īmēra te tono.
2. Ka waihangatia te kaiako i tētahi taepaetanga whakauru. Ko tō īmēra tō ingoa whakauru.
3. Ka whakarite e te kaiako i tētahi kupu huna mōhou.

Ka whakairi ake ngā tohutohu me ngā kōrero āhina ki runa i a Class Dojo.

Ka mutu, ka whakarite ake e te kaiako i ētahi wā hei āwhina i a koutou, pēnā ki te rā uiuinga mātua a te 30 o Hurae.

*We are excited to bring to our whānau, a project that the staff and Board of Trustees have been working on for 5 years. At the end of week 2, we will be launching our own purpose built, online reporting platform called Te Kete Whakairo.*

*This is a live platform to be used by our students, their kaiako and whānau. Its purpose is to make the travel of student achievement transparent and accessible.*

*Te Kete Whakairo has 2 platforms. The first platform is where our kaiako works with their students. Teachers can set assignments and tasks, and students can submit assessments and projects for evaluation. Kaiako will review and mark submissions, add evidence and assign your child's learning levels. Once endorsed, this information is then sent through to the second platform.*



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*The second platform is for parents / guardians and whānau. Kaiako will work with parents to create logins. These logins will give you access to a landing page where all your tamariki will be displayed with their administration details below. You will then be able to click on to your child's profile and it will display 3 areas:*

- 1. Your child's attendance*
- 2. Pastoral and behavioural information.*
  - a. Good behaviour*
  - b. Behavioural incidents*
- 3. Academic record.*

*This is to provide parents a view of how your tamaiti is achieving in the essential areas of – Attendance, behaviour and classwork.*

*Please understand that this platform does not exist in any other school, it was designed, built and delivered to you by the kura. It will require some time for both parents and kaiako to get used to, so we ask for your patience, understanding and feedback.*

*This is the first of its kind and we are excited about how we can collectively progress and develop platform to ensure whānau are better informed and involved in the education of our tamariki.*

*Next Steps:*

- 1. Kaiako will make contact with you. Please provide them with a current, working email address. For families with multiple children across the kura, the Kaiako of your eldest child will set your access up.*
- 2. Kaiako will create login details using your email address as your username.*
- 3. Kaiako will create a password for you then send you the link to the login page.*

*Basic instructions and tips on how to navigate the platform will be posted up on class dojo to help us start.*

*Kaiako will also organise more opportunities to assist including time at the next parent / teacher interviews, Wednesday July 30th.*



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## SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS

### School Board Elections - Parent Election Notice

Nominations are open for the election of **5** parent representatives to the school board.

All eligible voters will receive a nomination form. Use this form to nominate yourself or someone in your community. You will also receive a nomination cover letter calling for nominations. Information on who is not eligible to be a board member is provided with this notice, and the nomination form.

If you need more nomination forms, contact the school office.

Nominations close at **noon** on **August 8<sup>th</sup> 2025** You may provide a signed candidate statement and photograph with your nomination.

The electoral roll is held at the school and can be viewed during normal school hours.

As nominations are received, there will be a list of candidates' names kept at the school up until election day, which you can view.

Voting closes at **4pm** on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> September

### People who are not eligible to be school board members

The following people are not eligible to be school board members. A person who:

- is an undischarged bankrupt; or
- is prohibited from being a director or promoter of, or being concerned or taking part in the management of, an incorporated or unincorporated body under the [Companies Act 1993](#), or the [Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013](#), or the [Takeovers Act 1993](#); or
- is a permanently appointed member of the Board staff, unless they are standing for election as a staff representative; or
- contracts or sub-contracts with the Board without the approval of the Secretary of Education and receives payments exceeding \$25,000 in any financial year. This would also cover situations where a person has a 10% or more shareholding in the contracting company or a company that controls the contracting company; or



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- is subject to a property order under the [Protection of Personal and Property Rights Act 1988](#); or
- has been convicted of a specified offence identified in [Schedule 2](#) of the Children's Act 2014, unless that person has obtained a pardon or been granted an exemption; or
- is a person in respect of whom a personal order has been made under that Act that either the person is not competent to manage his or her own property affairs, or does not have the capacity to communicate/make decisions relating to his/her welfare/personal care; or
- is a person who has been convicted of an offence punishable by imprisonment for 2 years or more, or who has been sentenced to imprisonment for any other offence, unless that person has obtained a pardon, served the sentence, or otherwise suffered the penalty imposed on the person; or
- is not a New Zealand citizen, **and** is –
  - a person to whom [section 15](#) or [16](#) of the Immigration Act 2009 applies; or
  - a person obliged, by or pursuant to that Act, to leave New Zealand immediately or within a specified time, being a time that was less than 12 months; or
  - deemed for the purposes of that Act to be in New Zealand unlawfully.

A returning officer for an election (or by elections) of board members is not eligible to be nominated as a candidate in that election.
