

After a year and a half of preparations, planning and work with Tainui Group Holdings, The Ministry of Education informed us that they will no longer be following through with the purchase of the Tuumata Rise site as there is no budget allowance for the purchase in Budget 2025. An alternative approach is currently being explored.

B Block weather tightness remediation has been completed.

Te Kōpū Mania Sector 7 is on hold until the next 5YA planning starts July 2026 for 2027.

2026 recommendations:

1. The relocation project continues through 2026
2. The establishment of 2 new akomanga is completed
3. Cyclical Maintenance is strategically planned and based on budget allowance, completed 2026 / 27
4. Te Kōpū Mania be prioritised as a P3 in the new 5YA plan.
